## **LIVE AUCTION**

The auctioneer will suggest bid amounts. Any raised numbers will be recognized by the auctioneer. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the purchaser. **All sales are final and auction items may not be exchanged. St. Rose is not responsible for refunds due to bad weather, natural disasters, etc.**
